

# A Visit to the HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL CENTER

**Art Kirsh** has been a docent at the Holocaust Memorial Center for over 8 years. An educator for 37 years, he was one of the first teachers in Michigan to write a curriculum and teach about the Holocaust.

He has interviewed and recorded over 50 Holocaust survivor oral histories.



**Paula Marx-Bolton** was 13 years old when the Nazis stormed into her town in Poland and deported her family to the Aushwitz death camp. Only she survived. Because her mother always wore hats, Paula's stylistic signature is wearing a hat to remember and honor her mother's tradition.



As part of the "**Arsenal of Democracy**", the Packard Motor Car Company and its employees worked hard to defeat the evil that engulfed Asia and Europe, and threatened America, during the Second World War.

In Europe, that evil displaced 10's of millions of people, and murdered 11 million civilians, 6 million of whom were Jewish, including 1½ million children under the age of 15. This is known as the "Holocaust".

In the Holocaust Memorial Center, MCP member **Art Kirsh** will lead our tour of the state-of-the-art exhibits that vividly document that almost unimaginable tragedy that befell Europe's Jewish population—an incredibly rich culture which gave rise to individuals who made important contributions to literature, science, music, and the arts.

The Holocaust Memorial Center is also a place of solemn remembrance, where an eternal flame burns in honor of those who perished. We will meet **Paula Marx-Bolton**, a survivor of the Aushwitz concentrate camp, who will speak to us of her own personal story of survival.

Following the Center tour, we will meet at the Family Buggy, a homey family restaurant one mile up the road. See map on back.
